Before Reading

- Show the cover and title. Ask:
 - What do you already know about space travel?

During Reading

- Stop and talk about key topics:

 - What is life like on the International Space Station?
 - How is Mars being explored today?

After Reading

Reflect and discuss

- What was the most surprising thing you learned?
- Which space mission would you like to join?
- Why do you think it's important to explore space?



Activities

1. Design a Space Mission

- Where would you go? What would your mission be?
- Draw your spacecraft and explain what it does.

2. Timeline of Space Travel

- Make a simple timeline with 3–5 important space events.
- Include dates, a short fact, and a small picture or symbol for each one.

3. Space Fact Sheet

- Choose something from the book (like the Moon, a telescope, or Mars).
- Write 3–5 facts about it and share them with a partner or the group.
