Before Reading

During Reading

- What new things did you learn about how they live?
- How can we help rodents stay healthy and happy?



Activities

1. Rodent Fact Cards

- Choose three rodents from the book.
- Make fact cards with: name, habitat, diet, and interesting facts.
- Draw a picture of each rodent.

2. Rodent Habitat Map

- On a world map, mark where different rodents live.
- Use symbols for different habitats like deserts or forests.

3. Design Your Own Rodent

- Imagine a new rodent species.
- Draw it and write about its home, diet, and special traits.
