

Before Reading

- Look at the cover and title. What types of weather do you know? Ask:
 - What's your favorite kind of weather?
 - What do you know about the seasons?
 - Have you ever experienced extreme weather, like a storm or heavy snow?

During Reading

- Pause and talk about new information:
 - What do you notice about how weather is made?
 - What role does the Sun play?
 - How does weather affect people's daily lives?

After Reading

Discuss

- What was the most interesting weather fact?
- What did you learn about how seasons work?
- What would you like to explore more about weather or climate?



Activities

1. Weather and You

- Choose a type of weather (rain, snow, wind, etc.).
- Draw a picture of it and write a sentence about how it affects people.
- Optional: Add how it makes you feel.

2. Create a Season Wheel

- Make a circle divided into four parts.
- Label each part with a season: spring, summer, autumn, winter.
- Draw a symbol or activity for each season.

3. Weather Words

- Pick five new words from the book (like 'climate' or 'extreme').
- Write a definition and draw a picture to explain each word.
