Before Reading

- Look at the title and chapter list. What do you think this book is about?
- Discuss:
 - What do you know about blood and how it works?
 - Have you ever had a cut or nosebleed?
 - What questions do you have about how blood keeps us healthy?

During Reading

- After each section, ask:
 - What did you learn about blood or the circulatory system?
 - What does this part do in your body?
 - Why is it important?
- Use a diagram to track how blood moves around the body as you read.

After Reading

Group discussion

- What fact surprised you the most?
- What's the difference between red and white blood cells?
- How do you take care of your heart and blood vessels?



Activities

1. Blood Flow Map

- Create a diagram showing how blood moves through the body.
 - Label the heart, veins, arteries, and lungs.
 - Add arrows to show direction of blood flow.

2. My First Aid Poster

- Make a poster with tips for treating small cuts and scrapes.
- Include how to clean wounds and why scabs are important.
- Decorate it with fun drawings and facts.

3. Blood Cell Trading Cards

- Make two cards: one for red blood cells, one for white.
- Add:
 - Name
 - What it does
 - Fun fact
- Add a cool illustration for each!
